ALUMNI FEEDBACK CURRICULUM ANALYSIS REPORT 2017-18

Feedback of 201 alumni was collected during the academic year 2017-18. The result of the responses received from the alumni is analysed and the details of the same is as under:

- Out of total 201 alumni 89 (44.28%) rated that the adequateness of the courses offered in the program is excellent, 89 (44.28%) as very good, 21 (10.45%) as good and 1 (0.50%) as an average.
- 68 (33.83%) rate the sufficiency of syllabus content to bridge the gap between academia and industry as excellent, 116 (57.71%) opined that is very good and remaining 15 (7.46%) were of the opinion that is good and remaining 2 (1%) as an average.
- 83 (41.29%) of alumni rate the curriculum is in relation to the current professional standards thus excellent, while 66 (32.84%) believed it is very good, 48 (23.88%) believed it is good and remaining 3 (1.49%) believed it is average.
- 92 (45.77%) of the alumni were of the opinion that the skills acquired from the curriculum to face the industry challenges/requirements is excellent, 69 (34.33%) said it is very good, 37 (18.41%) opined it is good and 3 (1.49%) rate is as an average.
- 77 (38.71%) of the alumni rated the design of the courses in terms of extra learning or self-learning is excellent, 72 (35.82%) as very good, 46 (22.89%) as good and 4(1.99%) as an average.
- Training and placement cell is getting ample placement opportunities for students, thus 88 (43.78%) rated it excellent, 68 (33.83%) as very good, 41 (20.40%) as good and 3 (1.49%) as an average.
- The competence and support offered by the teachers is rated excellent by 86 (42.79%) alumni, while 71 (35.32%) rated it as very good, 41 (20.40%) as good and 2 (1%) as an average.
- The institute's support and contribution for the overall development of students is rated excellent by 87 (43.28%) alumni, while 70 (34.83%) rated it as very good, 41 (20.40%) as good and 3 (1.49%) as an average.
