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FACULTY FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM :ANALYSIS REPORT 2019-20

Feedback of 26 Faculties on curriculum was collected during the academic year 2019-20. The result of the responses received from the faculties is analysed and the details of the same is as under:

- Out of total 26 faculties 15 (57.69%) opined that the structure of the curriculum framed for the various programs is excellent and remaining 11(42.31%) opined that it is very good.
- 12 (46.15%) of the faculties are of the opinion that the sequences of the courses provided in the curriculum is appropriate excellent, 13 (50%) opined that is very good and remaining 1 (3.85%) were of the opinion that is good.
- 14(53.85%) of faculties believe that the depth of the syllabi for the courses are in relation to the competencies expected by industry/current global scenarios thus excellent, while 9 (34.62%) believed it is very good, 3(11.54%) believed it is good.
- 12 (46.15%) of the faculties were of the opinion that the sequence of the units/modules in the courses is excellent, 12 (46.15%) said it is very good, 2(7.69%) opined it is good.
- The distribution of credits to the courses is equal. 14 (70%) of the faculties rate it as excellent, 10 (20%) as very good and 2 (10%) as good.
- 15 (57.69) of the faculties rated that the adequateness of textbooks and reference books mentioned for the courses is excellent, 10 (38.46%) as very good and 1 (3.85%) as good.
- The potential of the students in understanding the course objectives is rated excellent by the 14 (80%) of the faculties, 11 (20%) as very good and 1 (3.85%) as good.
- 11(42.31) of the faculties rated that the syllabus content for the courses is burden on students.
- 14 (53.85%) of the faculties believed that the contribution of the courses is in terms of Professional core area that is excellent, 10 (38.46%) rated it as very good, 2 (7.69%) as good.

Based on the feedback and analysis of Alumni a committee of the following members met on 21-03-2021 and action plan was designed:





- 4. On regular basis suggestions and inputs will be taken with regards to emerging trends in various areas and the same will be incorporated in syllabi & curriculum.





