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### FACULTY FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM: ANALYSIS REPORT 2021-22

Feedback of 23 Faculties on curriculum was collected during the academic year 2021-22. The result of the responses received from the faculties is analysed and the details of the same is as under:

- Out of total 23 faculties 7 (30.43%) opined that the structure of the curriculum framed for the various programs is excellent, 12 (52.17%) opined that it is very good and remaining 4 (17.39%) opined that it is good.
- 3 (13.04%) of the faculties are of the opinion that the sequences of the courses provided in the curriculum is appropriate - excellent, 15 (65.22%) opined that is very good and remaining 4 (17.39%) were of the opinion that is good.
- 3(13.04%) of faculties believe that the depth of the syllabi for the courses are in relation to the competencies expected by industry/current global scenarios thus excellent, while 12 (52.17%) believed it is very good, 4 (17.39%) believed it is good and remaining 1 (4.35%) believed it is average.
- 8 (34.78%) of the faculties were of the opinion that the sequence of the units/modules in the courses is excellent, 12 (52.17%) said it is very good, 3(13.04%) opined it is good.
- The distribution of credits to the courses is equal. 8 (70%) of the faculties rate it as excellent, 11 (20%) as very good and 4 (10%) as good.
- 7 (30.43%) of the faculties rated that the adequateness of textbooks and reference books mentioned for the courses is excellent, 10 (43.48%) as very good and 6 (26.09%) as good.
- The potential of the students in understanding the course objectives is rated excellent by the 6 (26.09%) of the faculties, 15 (65.22%) as very good and 2 (8.70%) as good.
- 5 (21.74%) of the faculties rated that the syllabus content for the courses is burden on students.
- 6 (26.09%) of the faculties believed that the contribution of the courses is in terms of Professional core area that is excellent, 10 (43.48%) rated it as very good, and 6 (30.43%) as good.

Based on the feedback and analysis of Alumni a committee of the following members met on 21-03-2021 and action plan was designed:





- 4. On regular basis suggestions and inputs will be taken with regards to emerging trends in various areas and the same will be incorporated in syllabi & curriculum.





